I hope you all have a great week! Zac

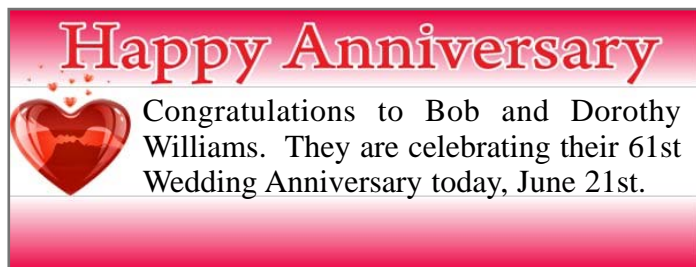

**Nursery: Birth to 18 months**

**Imagination Station: 3 years up to 4th Grade**

**Basic Training: 9 years - 12 years**

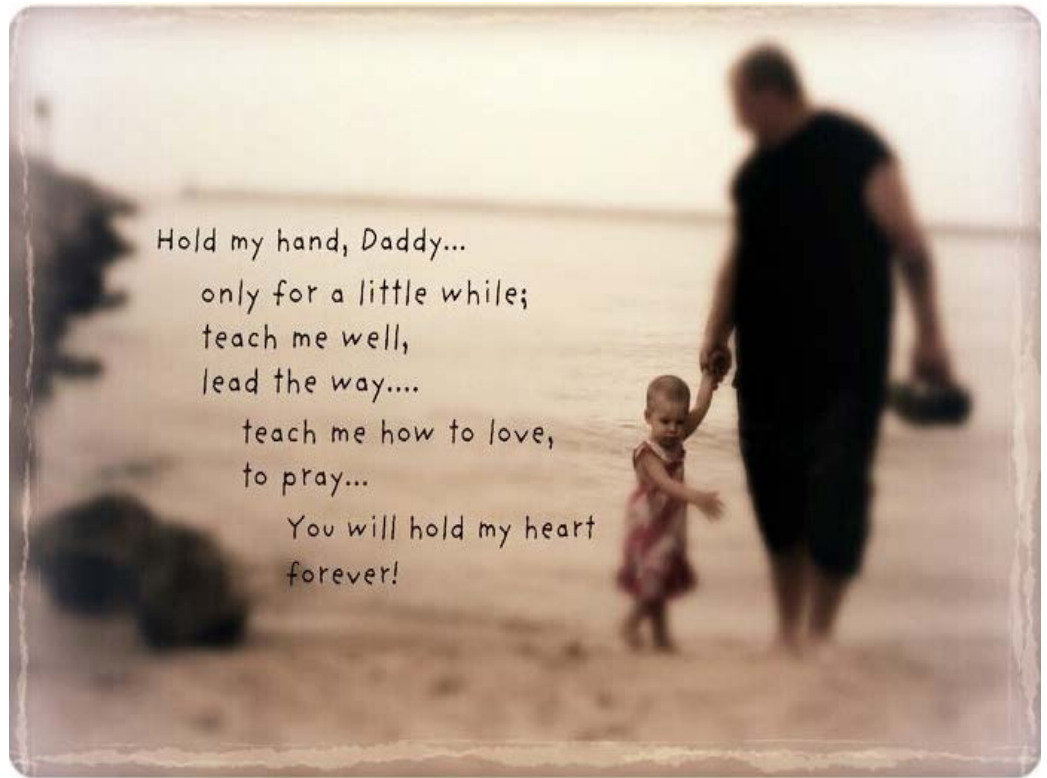
