

On the night of the storm, my husband was at home, the power had gone off, so he knew nothing about the tornado, until my daughter called. Upon hearing the news, Pete quickly drove to Joplin. He was however, unable to reach the hospital and was forced to walk half a mile. Once he reached the hospital, he saw all the chaos and still chose to enter the gas filled hospital, with a small flash light in hand, searching for me. He waded thru water and debris, and fallen lines. He searched my whole department at the hospital, until firemen spotted him, and for some reason, they assumed that he was one of them, calling to him, "Come on, I think that the building is finally evacuated, and we can leave." So Pete exited the hospital. It was completely dark by then, but he kept asking & searching for me. I finally was able to get someone to text him that I was safe and down at Memorial Hall. On his way to Memorial Hall, Pete encountered a road block. They were only allowing medical personal thru, so Pete became a nurse! It took my hero another couple of hours to finally reach me. I remember praying as a teenager, that God would bless me with a good husband and great father to our children. God truly answered my prayers. ~~ Shelba




