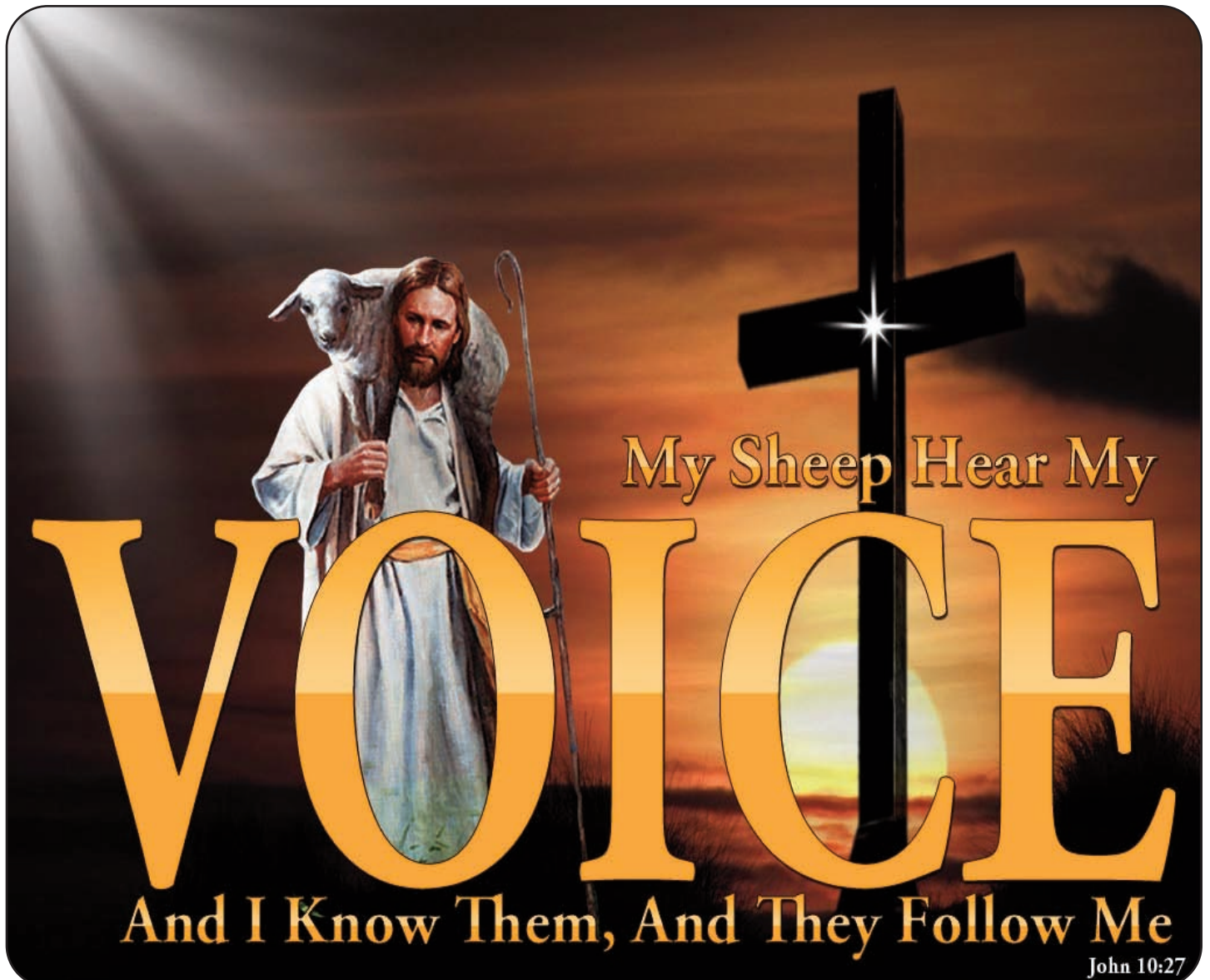

Encouragement and Counseling Ministry

Most of the time inaccurate assumptions are clarified when observations and thoughts are shared. This is called "Feedback and Processing". Giving feedback before and after activities, events and during everyday occurrences helps participants gain perspective and creates a sense of "connectedness as team members". It allows participants to make changes in "wrong assumptions," make course corrections and experience increased success. Bottom line, relationships and groups have a greater likelihood of surviving and possibly thriving during times of stress, trauma and crisis if they have well developed and practiced communication that includes feedback and processing.

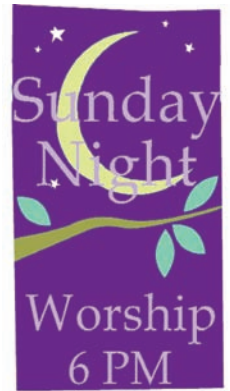
