# Encouragement and Counseling Ministry

There is a tendency as the summer heat reaches the mid-90's to remember the record breaking temperatures and regional drought we experienced in the summers of 2011 and 2012. Last summer an older gentleman described and compared the extremely hot and dry conditions to the early-to-mid 1950's where record breaking high temperatures were established and many remain some 60 years later. Our ability to remember and make comparisons is truly remarkable and fascinating. We are able to identify themes and patterns that may alert and alarm us or possibly sooth and allow us to feel more secure.

Similarly, there are times when intense and disconcerting memories are triggered by a particular movement in our immediate environment, a glimpse of a person from the past, distinct sounds and/or smells, seasonal changes and/or by a particular touch. What are we to do with sensory information associated with intense and/or painful memories? Merely saying, "Let's put it behind us and never mention it again" or by mentioning it every time we feel discouraged actually "makes the problem worse". Both approaches tend to leave us feeling more shallow and unsatisfied.

At the risk of coming across as insensitive or even outrageous, it is not intense and painful memories that tend to "hold or set us back." It is "unnegotiated loss" that allows strong negative memories to "flood our senses, washing over us" and sometimes "freezing us in place" or possibly finding ourselves "acting out" those very things that were so hurtful.

God wants us to participant in the depths of redemption and renewal. This involves addressing and working through issues involving loss. Reclaiming a strong sense of trust, commitment, hope and optimism may take tremendous amounts of time and effort, but it is well worth it. If something happened and the way it was handled hasn't worked well, I would like to help. Ralph

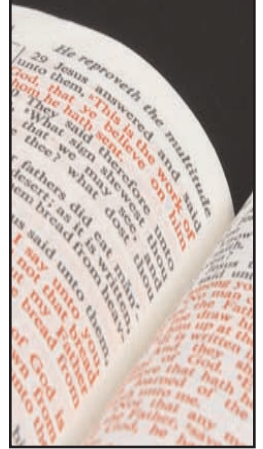
