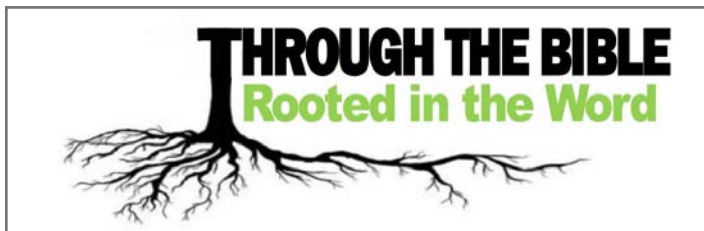

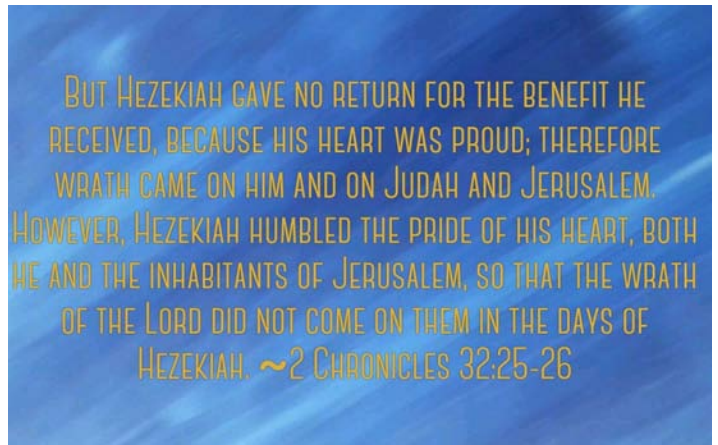
We want to welcome those visiting with us today. We are so happy you are here. You are our honored guests! We hope you experience the presence of God today.
