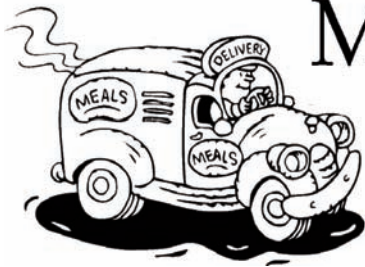

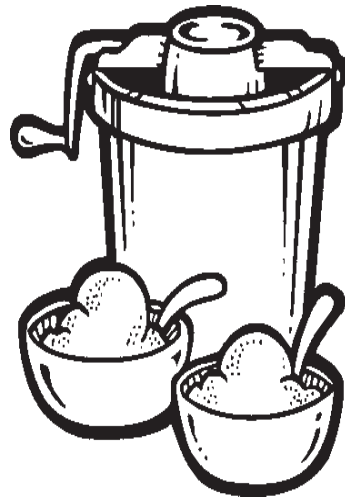
Responses

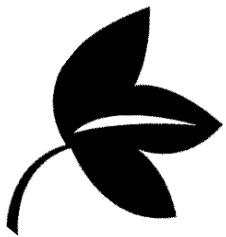

Encouragement and Counseling Ministry

At the beginning of July, a new ministry began that focuses on encouragement, counseling and recovery. Aspects of encouragement may be related to: developing our God given talents and abilities at any age, focusing on healthy attachments and connections between family members, couples enhancing their unique marital identity, exploring a shared parenting/grand parenting philosophy, etc. Counseling generally involves addressing changes, losses and making "course corrections." Circumstances usually involve significant events that impact other areas of our lives such as our spiritual relationship as sons or daughters to our heavenly Father, marital and /or parent/child relationships, occupational effectiveness, our health and sense of well-being and security. Recovery is needed when we experience a sense of being overwhelmed by critical situations and circumstances that have impacted two or more significant areas of our lives.
