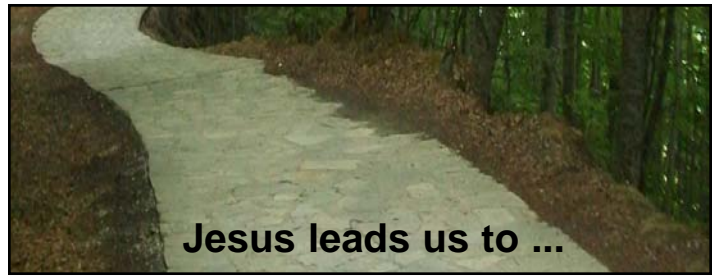
Fair Haven Children's Home
