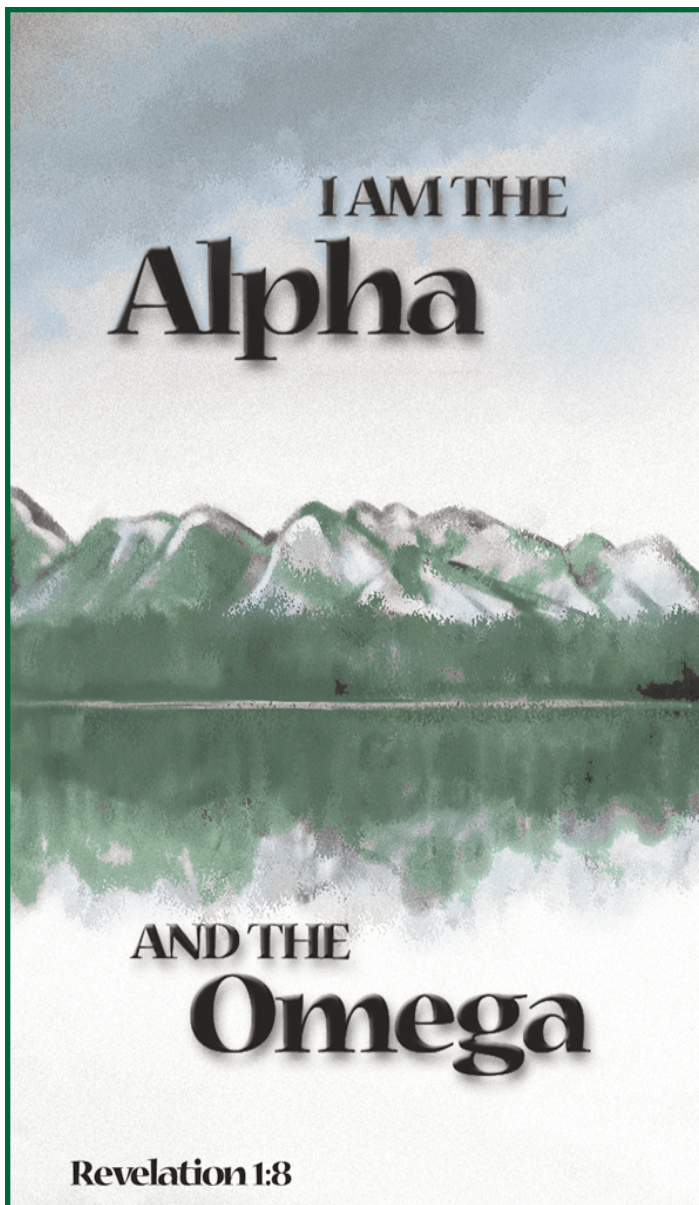

### Jesus And The Bible

The Bible is the *Revelation* of God. The word *revelation* means an unveiling. But an unveiling of what?

The answer is Jesus. At first gradually in the Old Testament through shadows and prophecies Jesus is hinted at, prophesied of and promised to come.

The New Testament tells of His arrival on earth, his life and his continuing work in the life of His church.

In this way, it is true as it is said, *The Old Testament is the New Testament concealed and the New Testament is the Old Testament revealed*. Only in Jesus is the whole Bible brought together in one common theme – the gradual unveiling of Jesus in the Old Testament and the full brightness of His glory in the New Testament.

Some miss the point. They see both the Old and New Testaments as sets of rules from God – different rules for different times – yet just rules nonetheless.

True, there are rules, laws and commandments throughout the Bible, but it is a mistake to see these as the main thing. They aren't. Jesus is the main thing and the only thing.

That's why Christianity must be seen as more than Jesus' new set of rules and instructions. To be a Christian means to enter into a relationship with Jesus, not just into understanding of the New Testament.

We should read the Bible, study it and seek to know all we can of God's Revelation, but we should be on guard not to miss what's being unveiled, or rather who. It is a Person. A Person with whom we can enter into a connection and relationship that leads to real life, the only life that will last.

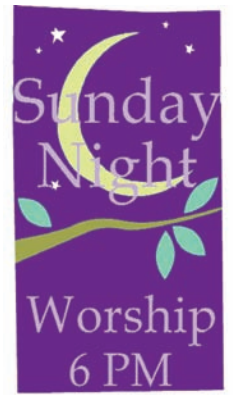
