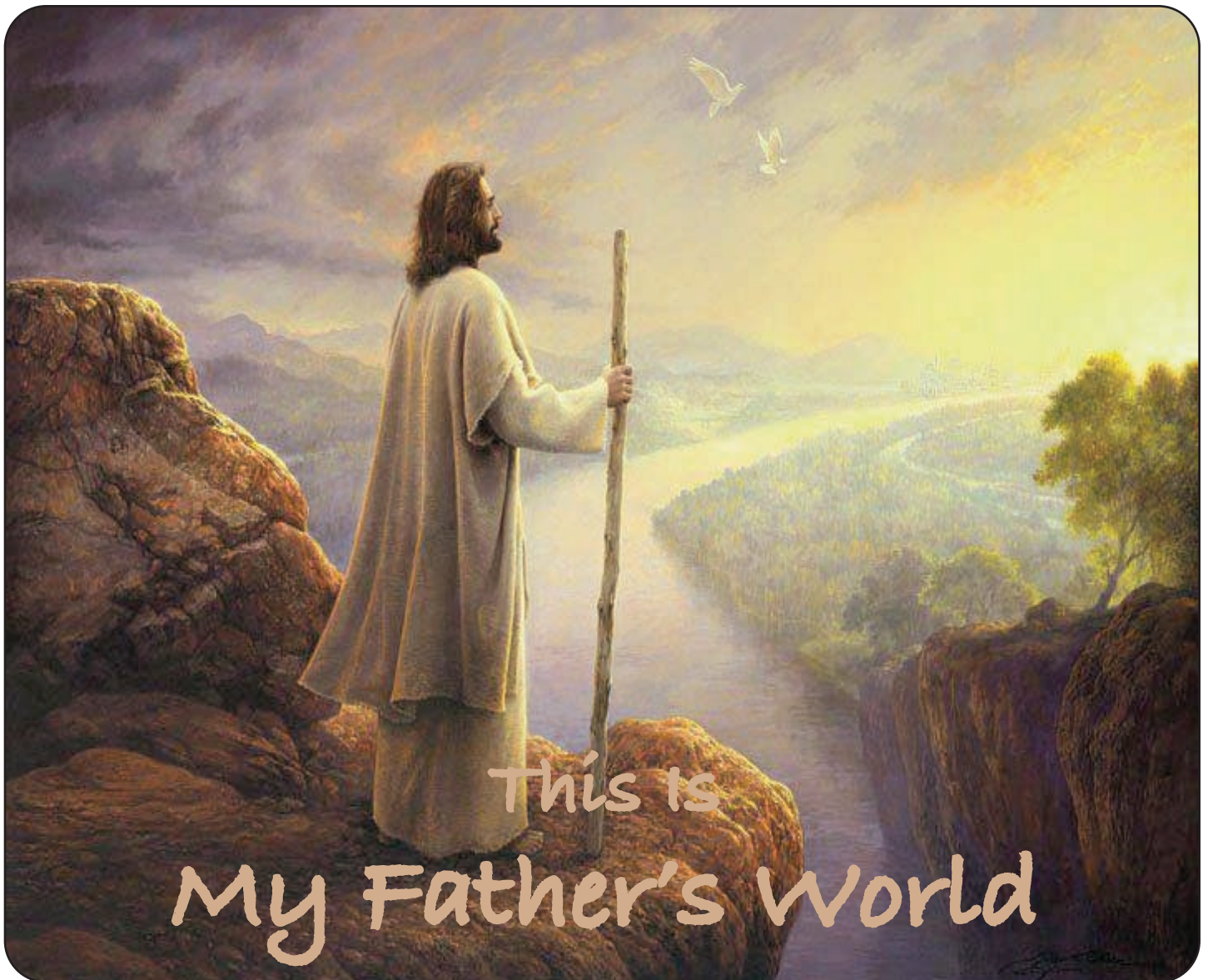

Encouragement and Counseling Ministry

Recently, at a memorial service a song elicited deep, yet highly positive feelings. The song's lyrics went, "If you get there before I do, don't give up on me, I'll be there when my chores are through". These phrases expressed characteristics of enduring devotion, commitment, loyalty and partnership. This level of honor adds motivation, meaning, inspiration and purpose to our "mostly routine lives". This kind of love is very responsive, yet able to "wait" for long periods of time when others are engaged in activities requiring their full attention. Trust and respect are at the core of these relationships allowing each other the freedom to develop their God given talents and abilities.

This is not to say that our honor and faith never wane nor does it mean we do not question a "turn of events." Scripture shares details of John, whose entire life focused on preparing the way for Christ, at one point sent his followers to ask Jesus if he was the Christ". John had previously identified Jesus as the Savior, stating "I need to be baptized by You". Then John was imprisoned and through the process of being condemned he questioned "where his efforts had led him and his followers" and if it was from God. Jesus told John's followers to return and tell him all that they had seen and heard.

There are times when we want guarantees and are unable to understand and accept a series of events. Whether life appears uneventful and dry for long periods of time or there are tragic situations occurring, we wonder if we have taken a "wrong turn or got off track". After the initial shock and reaction, our faith recalls how Jesus lived a pure life of service, yet was rejected and condemned. We remember how "saints of ancient times" endured victimization, torture and death. We remember how our contemporary teachers, mentors and family members maintained lives of enduring devotion, commitment, loyalty and an abiding partnership. Let us continue to devote ourselves to Jesus and one another, encouraging each other.

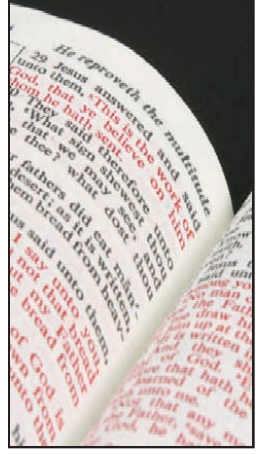
