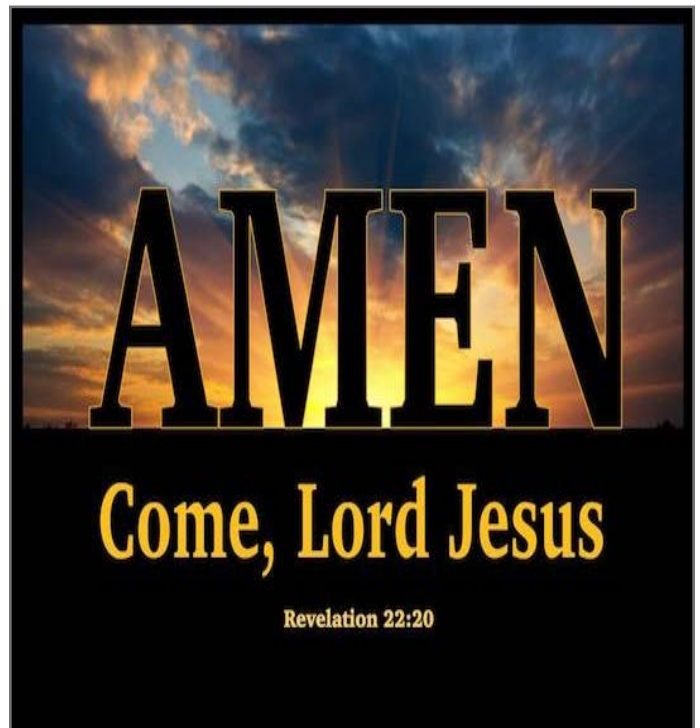

Why Should We Seek First His Kingdom?

Psalm 124:8

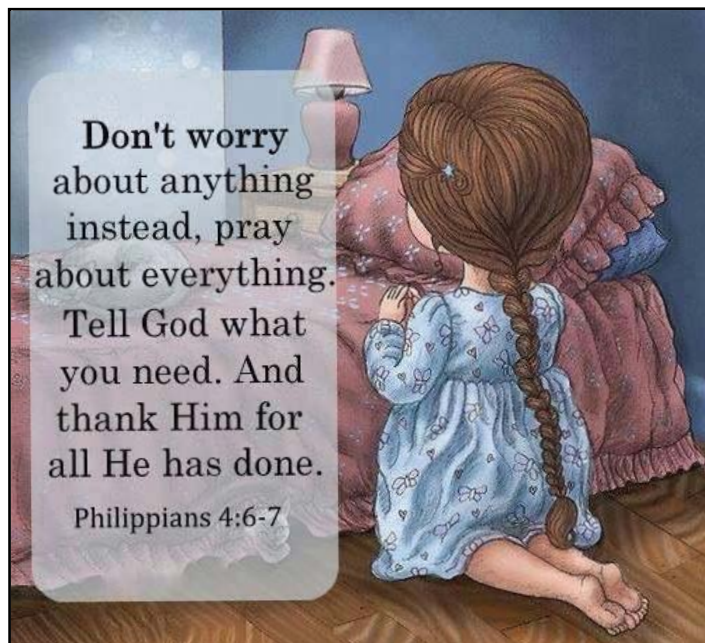
