Because we were late announcing their shower, you may place gifts in the wedding gift basket for Andrew and Moe until August 11th.

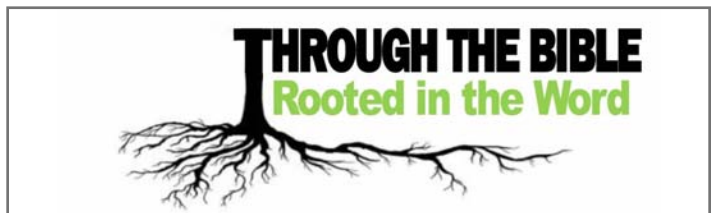
Fair Haven Children's Home
