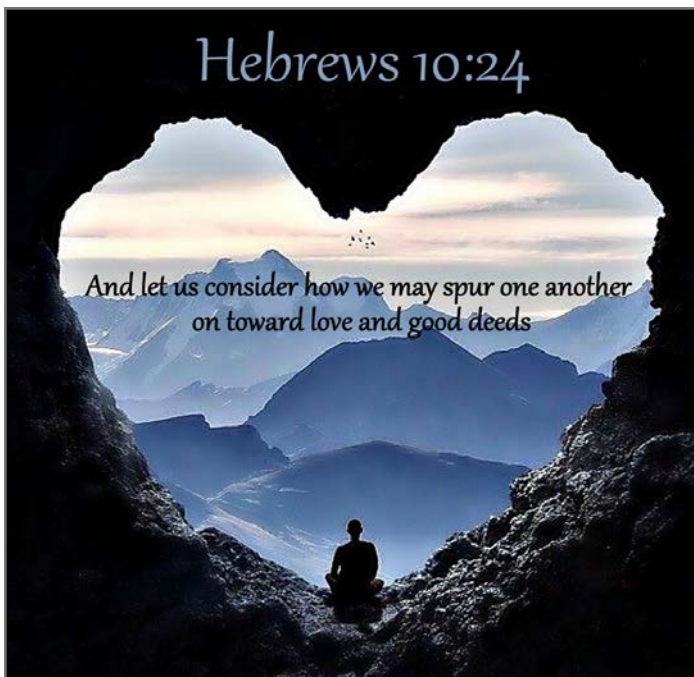

Seek First His Kingdom

There is, of course, much more to prayer than the Lord's Prayer. It is a prayer that teaches us to pray. It is a foundation of the praying life: its introduction and its continuing basis. It is an enduring framework for all praying. You only move beyond it provided you stay within it. It is the necessary bass in the great symphony of prayer. It is a powerful lens through which one constantly sees the world as God himself sees it.

The English wording long familiar in the King James Version is a treasure now interwoven with Western consciousness. It may be of some use in practice, however, to reword the prayer to capture better the fullness of its meanings and its place in the gospel of the kingdom:

Our Father always near us,
 may your name be treasured and loved,
 may your rule be completed in us –
 may your will be done here on earth
 in just the way it is done in heaven.
 Give us today the things we need today,
 And forgive us our sins and impositions
 on you as we are forgiving
 all who in any way offend us.
 Please don't put us through trials,
 But deliver us from everything bad.
 Because you are the one in charge,
 And you have all the power,
 and the glory too is all yours – forever –
 Which is just the way we want it!

'Just the way we want it' is not a bad paraphrase for 'amen'. What is needed at the end of this great prayer is a ringing affirmation of the goodness of God and God's world. If your nerves can take it, you might try 'Whoopee!' I imagine God himself will not mind.
