The September fellowship meal is today after the morning service. Everyone is invited to stay for some good food and fellowship.

GOD'S LOVE

Think for a moment about God's love for us.

But we shouldn't begin by immediately focusing on God's love for us because God's love doesn't start with us. Rather we should focus on a God who loves with a love that existed between the Father, Son and Holy Spirit before we ever came on the scene.

There are seven references in the New Testament to the Father's testimony about His love for His Son. Similarly there are seven passages where the Son Himself confirms His Father's love. For example, As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you. (John 15:9).

God loves us because that's who He is - God is love. And we only love Him because He first loved us.

Sometimes we are tempted to think that God's love is conditional. Yes, God loves us, or wants to, but will only really love us if we are pleasing to Him.

Is that true?

When God so loved the world that He gave His only Begotten Son, was it because the world was pleasing to Him? Not pleasing, but His love reached out to a creation made in His own image and to Him worth saving.

Surely we should try to please God, but however more our actions may please or displease Him, do we honestly think God will love us more or less than He already does in sending Jesus to die when we were not so pleasing?

The next time we are tempted to think we aren't pleasing to God and begin to question whether God loves us, just stop and remember that God's love does not spring from our merits or performance. The death of Jesus for our sins proves it is always all about His love and not at all about how pleasing we are, our goodness, or how hard we work.

This makes it natural to say - To Him be all glory and praise!

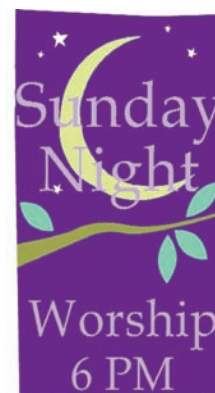
