We still have a few worker shirts from JumpStart which have not been turned in. Please give these to Wade Williams as soon as possible. We need to get everything put away until next year. Thanks.



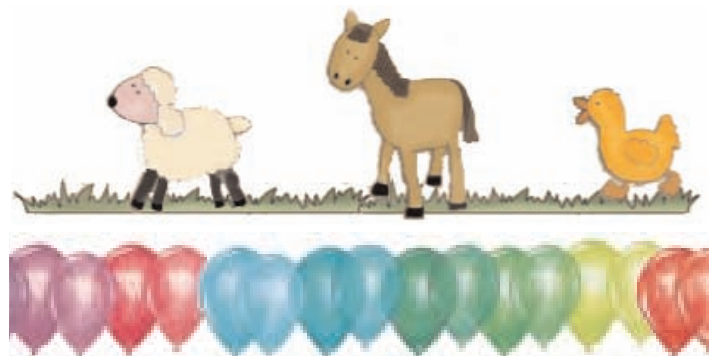

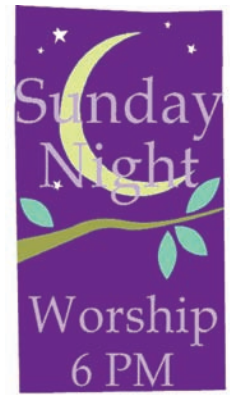
