Encouragement and Counseling Ministry

Our congregational family has been blessed in 2012 with newborn babies and devoted parents pursuing their needs. Parents recognize that attachment and bonding are sooooo important. When we as parents “put our time in up front” and establish that we are accessible, capable and responsive, then parenting youth may be more interesting and positive. There is a specific cycle which may be called the “Soul Cycle” that is developed within the beginning hours following the baby’s birth.

- ❖ In the first phase, an infant has a need, (i.e. hunger, pain, discomfort, fear, loneliness, etc.). The baby then expresses the need by whimpering or crying.
- ❖ If the need goes unmet, the baby’s crying usually increases in volume and intensity. The baby is saying, “I need something that I am totally helpless in obtaining.”
- ❖ In the third phase, the caregiver satisfies the baby’s needs by providing touch, motion, eye contact, a comforting sound, familiar scent, smiles and milk or food. When the baby’s needs are met in a timely and caring manner, a responsive and trusting relationship is established.
- ❖ In the final phase, as the baby’s needs are consistently met over a period of time then a secure attachment is established, thus completing the cycle. The cycle is completed many times on a daily basis. The ability to trust and bond enables children to develop strong connections and to later accept limits and controls.

There are occasions when attachments between children and parents experience disruptions just as there are circumstances where we as sons and daughters have a “tough time staying connected” to our spiritual Father, Creator and God. I have been greatly interested in both areas on a personal and professional basis. If I may be of assistance call the office at (417) 451-6698 and my cell number is (417) 214-7344. 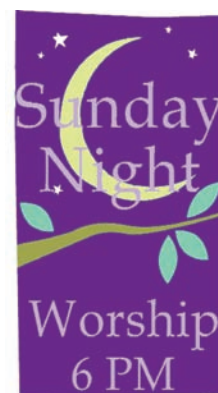
