

We will be collecting through September 27th. Below is the complete list of the specific items needed. **Today is the last day to donate items.**

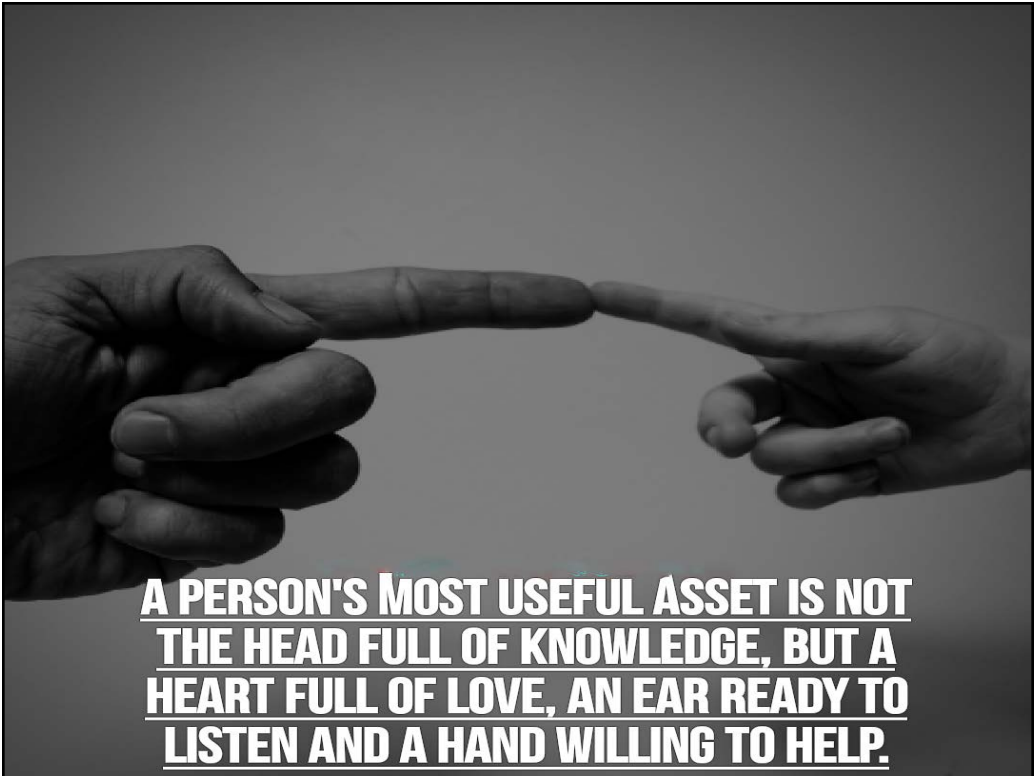
