Here are their names - Raisa, Valentina and Elizabeth (the youngest). All participants in the seminar were offered our assistance in organizing home churches and Bible groups, as well as all the necessary Christian literature and Bibles. A great blessing to all of us was the common acappella singing and learning new songs.

After the Sunday Worship, many people said words of gratitude and admiration for filling with the love and grace of God!

Our Daily Bible Reading this week began with Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem on what we call Palm Sunday. This is the beginning of what many call the Passion Week because it is the week that Jesus is arrested and put on the Cross. It is also because of the vast range of emotions (His passion) that we can read about Jesus experiencing as He is God being human. The Gospel writers focused on this week more than any other time of Jesus' life as the Passion Week fills more than 25% of the Gospels.

The emotions Jesus experiences during this week are indeed vast. Jesus enters into Jerusalem humbly, riding on a young donkey, while the people are celebrating with joy that He is King. He gets angry at a fig tree and people misusing the Temple. He is happy teaching his disciples and loving as he heals and blesses. He is sad, declaring betrayal, and in anguish in the Garden before His Father. Jesus experiences and shows joy and anger, love and loss, sadness and happiness, hunger and fullness, life and death during this week of passion.

Praise God we have a Savior who shows us that God knows what it is to be human, yet without sin! He is with us in all of the emotions of life, delivering us from the times that we live into these emotions poorly!

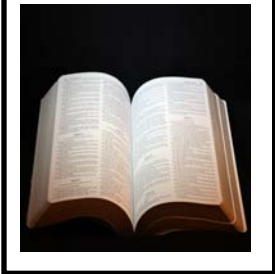
